Golden Rules

Partner Up: Always have a "Grown-up Co-Pilot" nearby. They are there to help with sharp edges, hot tools, or tricky measurements. This icon indicates that something needs an adult to prevent accidents.



Dress the Part: Wear old clothes or an apron. If you're doing a science experiment, put on your safety goggles to protect your eyes—they're your most important tools!

Create a "No-Fly Zone": Keep your workspace clear. Make sure food and drinks are far away so they don't get mixed up with your supplies.

Test, Don't Taste: Craft supplies and science ingredients might look cool, but they are never for eating or drinking. Keep your fingers away from your eyes and mouth while you work.

The Clean Sweep: When you're finished, wash your hands with soap and water and help your Co-Pilot tidy up.
